Full name	Johann Wolfgang von Goethe
Date of birth / Age	28, August. 1749/ 82
Place of birth	Free Imperial City of Frankfurt
What was he/she famous for?	Johann Wolfgang von Goethe was a German writer, poet, novelist, and playwright. He also worked as an actor, administrator, scientist, geologist, botanist, and philosopher. Famous lines from his books are often quoted, and some of his phrases have become part of the German language.
Job / Occupation	Johann Wolfgang von Goethe was a poet, novelist, playwright, natural philosopher, diplomat and civil servant.
Training / skills needed for this occupation	Goethe first studied languages, although he had always been passionate about art and never stopped cultivating it, making various drawings. When Goethe was writing his first literary works, he became interested in other areas of knowledge, such as chemistry, geology and medicine.
Greatest achievement	Johann Wolfgang von Goethe is perhaps the best known for the Sorrows of Young Werther (1774), the first novel of the Sturm and Drang movement, and for Faust (Part 1, 1808; Part 2, 1832), a play about a man who sells his soul to the Devil that is sometimes considered Germany's greatest contribution to world literature.

What was he/she famous for?	He was a crucial figure in the transition between the classical and romantic eras in classical music and is considered to be one of the greatest composers of all time.
Job / Occupation	Composer and pianist.
Training / skills needed for this occupation	Be able to compose; To know techniques of playing the piano
Greatest achievement	His seventh symphony premiered in 1813; Für Elise; Missa Solemnis.

Date of birth / Age	5 May 1818
Place of birth	Trier, Prussia, German Confederation
What was he/she famous for?	He was famous because he was known as one of 3 principal architects of modern social science.
Job / Occupation	He was a philosopher, economist, historian, sociologist, political theorist, journalist and socialist revolutionary.
Training / skills needed for this occupation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Critical thinking;• Creativity;• Power of analysis;• Rhetoric power.
Greatest achievement	Marx's ideas have had a profound impact on world politics and intellectual thought. Followers of Marx have often debated among themselves over how to interpret Marx's writing and apply his concepts to the modern world. The legacy of Marx's thought has become contested between numerous tendencies, each of which sees itself as Marx's most accurate interpreter. In the political realm, these tendencies include Leninism, Marxism-Leninism, Trotskyism, Maoism, Luxemburgism and libertarian Marxism. Various currents have also developed in academic Marxism, often under influence of other views, resulting in Marxism. Historical Marxism, phenomenological Marxism, analytical Marxism and Hegelian Marxism.

What was he/she famous for?	Politician; Served as the leader of the centre-right Christian Democratic Union; Obtained the largest share of the vote, and Merkel was able to form a coalition government with the Free Democratic Party; She is the Chancellor of Germany since 2005.
Job / Occupation	German politician serving as a chancellor in Germany
Training / skills needed for this occupation	Argumentative ability; Organisation ability; Leadership; Persuasiveness; Management skills; Oratory ability.
Greatest achievement	Leader of the Christian Democratic Union; Bundestag Leader of the CDU/CSU Group; General Secretary of the Christian Democratic Union; Minister for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety; Minister for Women and Youth; Member of the Bundestag; Personal details.
